LIBRARY UPDATES

Operations

The Library's board has approved additional operating hours for the summer months; we will be open until 8pm on Tuesdays from May 19th through August 29th, which is an additional 4 weeks of evening hours compared to 2024. As our staffing and budget allows, we hope to be able to expand evening hours in future years to better accommodate all community members.

We're excited to partner with a statewide program called Manpower to hire a couple of teen interns this summer. Over the past few years, we've been able to provide eight internships for local youth, providing a supportive environment for them to learn essential customer service skills and explore their career interests.

Due to a March executive order, the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) is currently being dismantled. The IMLS provides funding to the state of Maine to subsidize shared library services like interlibrary loan and Cloudlibrary (our ebook platform) and to provide essential support and consulting for libraries. Cuts are already beginning to occur at the state level, which could increase costs for MML to continue to access these services in the future.

Programs

Recent programs have included hands-on technology workshops on cybersecurity and graphic design, our nature-based play group for young kids, our biweekly postpartum support group, a library easter egg hunt, and community birding walks.

Upcoming programs include a free workshop on business planning for artists/makers and creative entrepreneuers, our monthly "Mending Meet-up", a Celtic heritage night, and a series of drawing and painting classes for kids.

Facilities

After our plans fell through in 2024, we have found a new contractor to take on our patio and drainage project this year. Starting in May, Whitney Martin will be regrading the land behind our Children's Room to slope away from the building and putting in an attractive brick patio on top. This should provide more functional space for outdoor programs and help address some of our recurring drainage issues. The patio and regrading work will be paid for using a combination of our capital reserve funds, and grants and donations received for this project.

Fundraising

We are planning an Anniversary Celebration to commemorate 10 years of being a nonprofit on July 5th from 2-4pm. The event will include music, family activities, library tours, storytellers, and speakers, and we hope it will serve as much as an open house as a fundraiser. I encourage the Town Council and the public to attend.

I submitted a \$400,000 grant request to the Sewall Foundation back in February, and we expect to officially hear back from them by the end of April.

Gear Library

Thanks to the Outdoor Sport Institute's grant writing efforts, the gear library will be able to update its fleet of bikes this spring! We are considering a couple options for the old bikes, including launching an "Earn a Bike" program or doing a used gear sale.
